we have a few extra that are not spoken for.

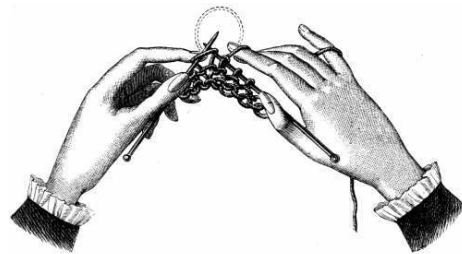

We'll focus on the three major seams you encounter in the knitting world, as well as the infamous Kitchener stitch.

(Which isn't *nearly* as difficult as you think. *Really.*)
