Praise wool! The Brooklyn Tweed *Early Fall 2018* collection has arrived at the shop with eight designs from Brooklyn Tweed Designers Véronik Avery, Jared Flood, Norah Gaughan, Julie

Hoover and Gudrun Johnston.

The collection features five garments and three accessories in worsted-spun, breed-specific *Arbor*, *Peerie* and *Vale*, all inspired by the colors, textures, and shapes of origami, the art of paper folding. These are easy-to-wear basics and eye-catching, sculptural pieces — all constructed in ways that are most definitely clever and off the beaten path.

We encourage you to stop in the shop to oogle, pet, squish and try on these samples between now and February 10th--any of them would make an ideal project for Deep Winter.

Indulge in the satisfaction of watching embossed shapes unfold with this heavily textured pullover. Foldlines melds multiple genres of hand making, opening the eyes to the creative ways in which fabric can be manipulated for stunning visual and tactile effect. Constructed to be uncomplicated in shape for relaxed wearing and to highlight the all-over geometric motif reminiscent of a four-pointed origami star, Foldlines is sure to integrate easily into your trousseau.

Dotted with a symmetrical arrangement of eyelets, the Kenchiku Wrap's lace motif builds off of each repeat to resemble chain link or rows of crowned hearts, depending on the piece's orientation. Delicate in nature but donning the strength of its design without sacrificing tensile cohesion, Kenchiku is a true testament to the magic of lace knitting that takes full advantage of Vale's ethereal fabric.

Spouts wears like sculptural art, reminiscent of mountain folds, formed by a clever combination of knits, purls, yarn overs, and unexpected bind off and cast on maneuvers. Apart from being intriguing, this scarf maintains a sanguine sense of humor while imparting many a lesson about the exciting possibilities of shaping stitches off the beaten path.

Orime is a demure top designed and crafted with an eye for impeccable detail and finishing. Knit stitches arranged diagonally on a background of reverse stockinette create lines that mimic creases on pleated paper; the folded over collar and neckline facing adds a stabilizing, professional touch. Featuring textures and techniques befitting of its name, which means “fold” in Japanese, this piece encapsulates precision while remaining true to the quiet, intuitive, and tactile joy of creating by hand.
