URSA MAJOR:
NOW WITH SPARKLES



Ursa Major was our May 2015 feature for the **Sleeping Bear Yarn Club**. Dyed exclusively for us by Anzula Luxury Fibers in California, this deep blue yarn is the ultimate Northern Michigan night sky-this time with sparkles! We've offered this colorway to our club members before, but on an entirely different base. **This is a limited edition and we're offering it to all customers--not just yarn club members.** Each skein has 400 yds (100g) and is comprised of 86% superwash Merino wool, 15% sparkling Stellina.

One skein will make a pair of socks to fit most sizes, as well as a shawllette and two skeins will make a large shawl.

SOCKS FOR SUMMER KNITTING



Socks are one of the best projects to have on hand for summer knitting; light enough to toss in your purse or backpack, small enough to pull out while having a patio drink with friends and not too warm on your lap that you can't take your knitting to the beach. Socks are also a great way to test out new knitting techniques, including two-color stranded knitting, as is pictured in the **Luna Socks Kit** we're featuring this week.

Worked partly in stockinette stitch and partly in a simple stranded colorwork pattern, these socks were created to add a pop of bright color to your outfit. The socks are worked from the cuff-down, with a standard heel flap (which can be easily replaced by your preferred method) and a bit of kitchener stitch to close the toes. This pattern is needle-neutral (to work with either double-pointed or circular needles).



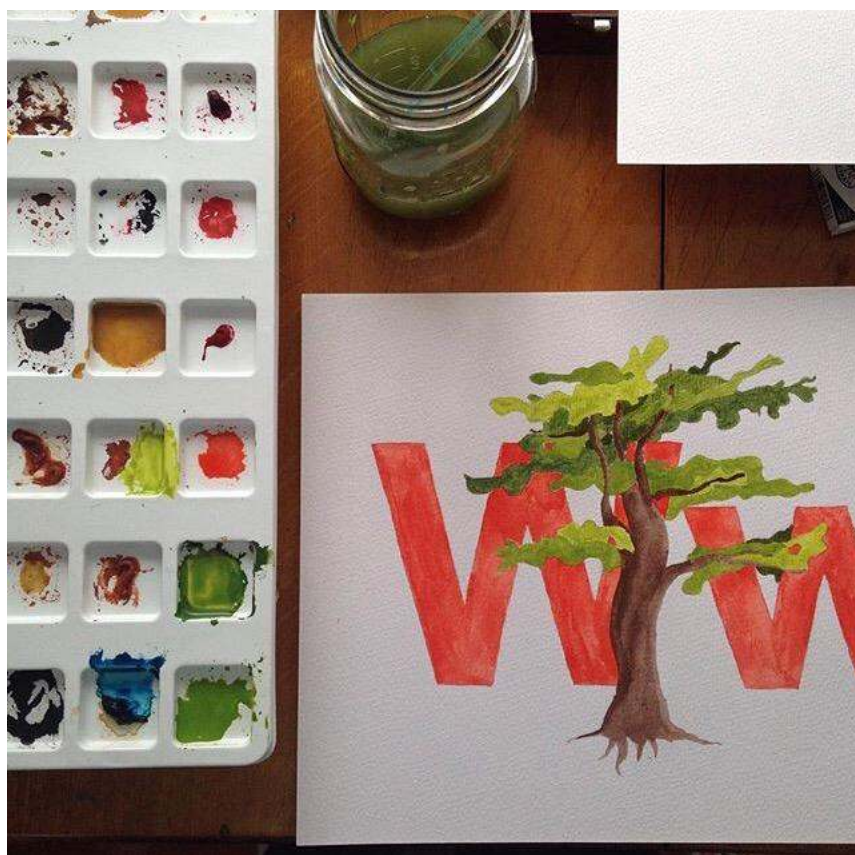
The kit comes with two skeins of Socks Yeah! in contrasting colors and one easy-to-read pattern.

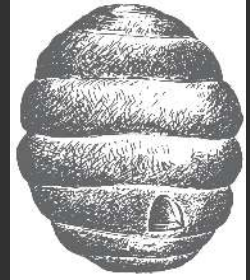
