Drop a stitch? Not entirely sure how to read a chart? Need a refresher on the Kitchener Stitch? We're here to help tackle your knitting quandaries, no matter how big or small. These sessions will be held at The Granary, a cozy, light-filled cottage just 6 miles north of Cedar. We'll have tea and coffee (and perhaps a sweet treat for sustenance!), as well as good company.

Finishing Techniques: A Knitting Workshop

One of the most important aspects of knitting isn't the actual knitting--it's the sewing, seaming & wrestling that some cleverly call "finishing". Knowing how to match up the proper techniques insures overall knitting success. This session will put you at ease, leaving you to create pieces you're proud to call hand-knit. We'll focus on the three major seams you encounter in the knitting world, as well as the infamous Kitchener stitch.

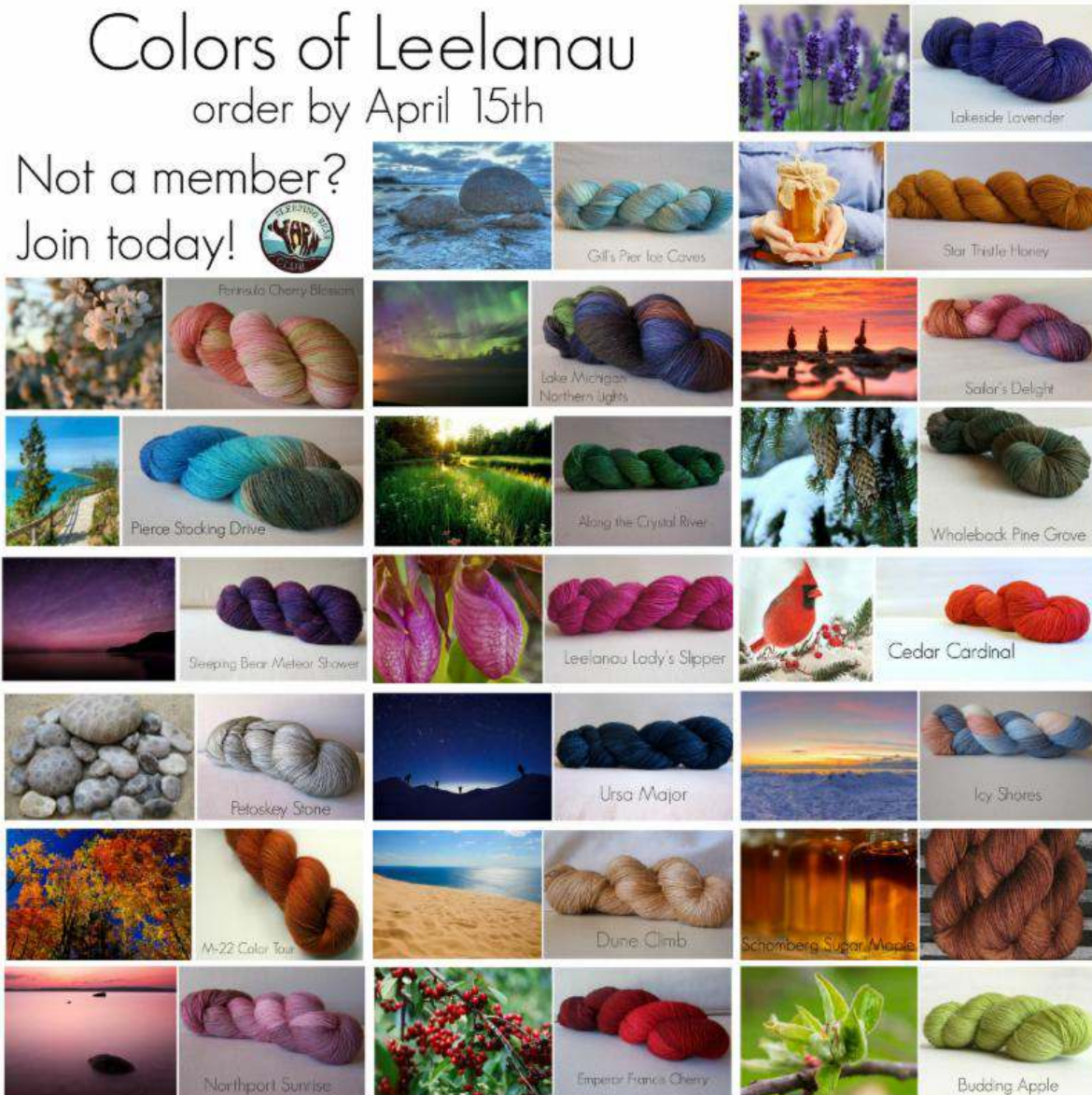

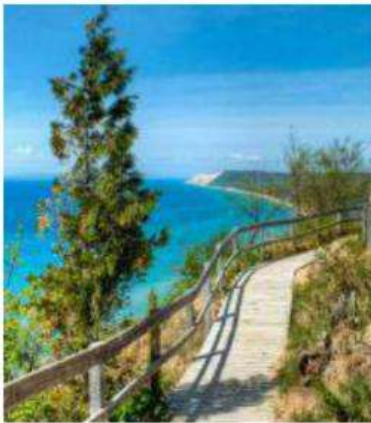

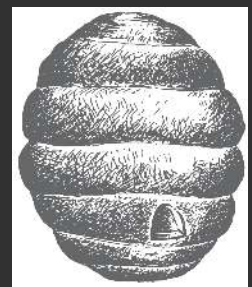
