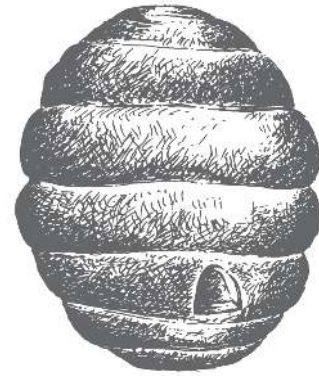

TOMORROW, MAY 10TH**



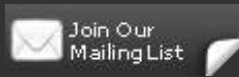
