The original Malabrigo Merino Worsted is a kettle-dyed Merino wool with the subtle variations in color and texture that only hand-dyed yarns can have--and all the sensuality of a good handspun yarn. This worsted weight yarn is great for mittens, hats, scarves, cowls, baby garments and adult sweaters.

Cabled Wrists Pattern

This is a fingerless mitt pattern with four cable-stitch pattern variations. Three of the mitt patterns have cables that lean in opposite directions for the right and left hands, so they mirror each other.

One pattern has a symmetrical cable, so it is the same for both the right and the left hands. Each mitt has welts at both the bottom and the top. They are knitted at a tighter gauge than is typical for a worsted weight yarn, using a smaller needle.
