Three Felted Bowls

Keeping clutter to a minimum (or at least storing clutter in an attractive way!) can be a full time job. These little felted vessels help enormously.

They're about as simple as they come--a knitted tube, essentially (with few decreases thrown in for shaping), a bit of hand felting and you're done.

Knit one for the entryway table to house keys and spare change, one for your knitting needles and one for a vase of flowers! (Inside the tall white version is a pint-sized Mason jar to stabilize the bowl.) And here's another little something to think about:
