On one interior wall is a panel divided into one medium-sized pocket (perfect for your phone and/or small notebook) and three narrow pockets for needles, tools or writing

implements. On the opposite interior wall is one long pocket, sized to hold a folded pattern.

That pocket is also punctuated by three smooth, antiqued grommets for those times when you're working from multiple balls and could use a little help keeping them untangled. Whether you're alternating skeins or doing colorwork, simply run the yarns up through the guides and they'll keep you nice and tidy--and so will everything else about this beautiful bag!
